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1. PAYMENT METHOD

Due to the increase in the paperwork for opening new bank accounts we are going to remain with the existing account that was opened for the Commonwealth Veterans Event in 2009. The details for payment are therefore as follows:

The Fees are £65 per individual fencer and £160 for each team.

3. INFORMATION ON THE OPENING CEREMONY AT THE HOTEL DE FRANCE

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor of Jersey General Sir John McColl KCB, CBE,

DSO and Lady McColl have agreed to attend the opening ceremony which will take place in their presence at the Hotel De France on the evening of Sunday 12th February starting at 18.30. The Opening will start at 18.30 with a Parade of Flags followed by the Welcome Speeches. There will be a 3 course Buffet Dinner. The cost for this evening will be £20.00 per person. Please note that the Hotel packages are not providing dinner on this night as it is hoped that you will all attend this event. 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4. REFEREEING

Following a decision reached at the 2010 CFF Annual Meeting in Melbourne, we will be implementing a proposal made by the Member Nations regarding refereeing at CFF Championships. The CFF Technical Commission will be identifying and selecting a cadre of FIE Qualified referees to officiate in Jersey. This project is being implemented on a trial basis and means that, at this event, no delegation needs to provide referees. The Member Nations indicated that this would allow for a more equitable distribution of the overall cost of providing referees as each and every participant would this way share equally in the costs. Based on each delegation's total number of entries, the Member Nations participating will be charged a refereeing levy that will represent their share of the refereeing costs. The Technical Commission will make the necessary arrangements to secure the services of the required referees. The exact amount of each participating Member Nations' levy will be communicated to them as soon as final numbers have been determined (deadline date for submission of entries is December 21st).
