

- Seating Capacity 1000
























Spectators/ Tickets

- Day and medal match tickets each day
- All fencers and registered team staff will have a seat
- Between 600 and 700 tickets available per day
- Week passes
- Tickets available online 6 months before

The Event: Format

- 6 days of events, 2 medal events each day
- Days 1-3: Individual Events
- Days 4-6: Team Events
- Gala Finals each evening at 1700 -2100


